In this semester students are taught how to credit outside sources properly by following the most recent APA Manual of Publication. Students analyse scientific articles on psychology from the perspective of using outside sources, specifically how to use in-text citations, how to compile a list of references, and how to paraphrase correctly. The course also reviews the use of passive voice and reported speech in academic writing. The lessons in this course cover topics such as cognition, language and children's development, mental disorders and popular misconceptions about mental disorders. Description of the course	<p>The course develops academic writing skills by focussing on argumentative essays and cause/effect essays, both very common in writing in psychology. Students are taught various linguistic resources used in argumentative writing and cause/effect writing, as well as specific transition signals used in such writing. The course also covers various discussion topics, such as modern addictions and contemporary psychological issues related to digital communication, e.g. cyberbullying and different forms of psychological violence through online communication and through social media. An additional topic is also the psychology of making decisions. The language focus of the course is on the use of verbal structures such as infinitives, gerunds, and participles, as well as the use of modal verbs. During the course students are required to analyse a scientific journal article on a topic in psychology from a grammatical point of view, and at the end of the semester students present the paper to their colleagues through an oral presentation and/or workshop.</p>
